

GATRA Bus FAQs

What towns does GATRA provide rides to?
Bus service is provided to the towns adjacent to Carver.

What is the fee for riding the GATRA bus?

The fee is \$1.75 each way. A book of 10 passes can be purchased for \$15. A book of passes makes a great gift for any senior in your life that needs transportation!

How do I schedule a ride?

Call 508-866-4698 x-1 prior to 12 pm two days before.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR WHEELCHAIR PASSENGERS:

Wheelchair passengers who need assistance upon arrival to their destination should arrange to have a companion ride with them since the Gatra drivers are unable to escort passengers beyond their arrival point.

If a companion is unavailable to you, arrangements can be made to provide one for you. Please let the dispatcher know.

SPECIAL NOTICE

Due to increased ridership, reservations for Gatra Bus trips need to be made as far in advance as possible.

As soon as you make your doctor's appointments call the dispatcher at 508-866-4698 x1 to make a reservation for transportation as well.
